Frequently Asked Questions

What's the Radio Station? – 88.9 FM

Where is Tech? – Tech is in the back of Lane 5 in the staging lanes

What's the minimum age to drive a motorized vehicle? – You must be 16 years of age and hold a valid driver's license to operate any vehicle on the property. The speed limit is 10 MPH

Where do I go for my Double Entry? - The Timing Tower - 2nd Floor

What's considered a Double Entry? – We allow 1 Driver and 1 Car to make a total of 2 passes per complete round of competition for all classes. Drivers may only Double Enter in the Top, Mod, or Pro Bike categories

When can I sign up for points? - You can sign up for points at any time of the day as long as the tower has not begun calculating points totals at the end of the day.

When is my dial in required to be on my car? – It is HIGHLY RECOMMEND as a courtesy to your fellow competitor that your dial-in be on the car when you are less than 3 pairs from entering the burnout box. Dial-In's may not change once you exit the Staging Lanes

Where should I have my Dial In and Car Number? - The Timing Tower is located on the passenger side of the vehicle. Please make sure there is a legible Dial In & Car Number on that side of the vehicle, as well as a car number on all sides of the vehicle.

Where am I allowed to change which lane I want in the staging lanes? — Drivers are committed to their lane choice after they pass the lane markers hanging in the air shortly before the tech building. Any driver who is found to change lanes after this by a Track Official will be moved back to their original choice of lane in the position they would have been in.

What if my Junior Dragster turns off or has issues after firing? – Junior Dragsters are allowed to re-fire as long as they have not completely crossed the white line at the front of the staging lanes past the gate.
